


Dear Friends in Christ,

I want to thank you for your thoughtful and prayerful response to our survey regarding changes in our weekend Mass schedule. The responses from the surveys certainly confirm that there is interest in a later morning Sunday Mass in English. By far, the possible new schedule that parishioners liked the most was the “A” option, which left the current English Sunday morning Mass schedule the same (7:30 a.m. and 9 a.m.) with the addition of a Mass in English at 10:30 a.m. The “B” (8 am. and 10 a.m.) and “C” (7:15 a.m., 8:45 a.m., 10:30 a.m.) options were equally liked the least. What I like most about the “A” option is that it is the least disruptive to our current morning Mass schedule. Provided that we can recruit the liturgical volunteers that we will need for the addition of an English Mass at 10:30 a.m., I propose that we begin the new Mass schedule the first Sunday of October.
